- For conditions that are not serious or life threatening

- · For conditions that are not life-threatening
- Care from a board-certified doctor anytime anywhere in the United States via phone or video*
- Doctors can consult, diagnose, and prescribe medications
- Common conditions include cold and flu symptoms, allergies, congestion and sinus problems, and ear infections**

In-person care options



See your Doctor (\$)

- · Preventive or routine care
- Health issues that are not urgent or life-threatening
- If urgent, ask about same-day virtual visits via phone or online



Urgent Care (\$\$)

- Health issues that aren't life threatening but can't wait until the next day and need in-person care such as moderate burns, cuts and wounds, stitches and sutures**
- · Open evenings and weekends



Emergency Room

- Serious pain or life-threatening illness or injury, such as suspected heart attack or stroke, breathing problems, broken bones**
- · Will cost you the most
- Always call 911 or go to the emergency room if you are in severe pain or your condition is life-threatening
